
MEN'S BIBLE STUDY

UNITED METHODIST MINNESOTA ANNUAL CONFERENCE

I want to thank FUMC for the opportunity to attend the United Methodist Minnesota Annual Conference, which was held May 31-June 1 of this year. The theme of this year's Conference centered around Jesus, and the Road to Emmaus, Luke 24:13-35.

It was amazing to hear our new Bishop, Lanette Plambeck, speak, along with Bishop McAlilly from Nashville. They spoke of courage, boldness and love in the church.

There were several pieces of legislation. One included the UMC sending letters to our elected officials about banning the sale of assault-style weapons and devices that increase the speed of firing. The vote was yes.

The second approved resolution was adopting a resolution calling upon the U. S. Government about the rights of Palestinian children being detained by Israel. This was also voted yes and was to be sent to the 2024 General Conference.

The Love Offering from the Churches in the Conference was \$40,000.00.

There was also recognition for many of the Methodist Clergy, including the retirement of our own, Pastor Wayne Swanson.
